**Notes:**

1. In order to ensure breadth of knowledge about Asia, no more than two electives from a single discipline or focusing on the same country can count toward the minimum of four electives (for the minor) or five electives (for the combined major).
2. Foundational courses are listed as such in the University catalogue, but please check with the Asian Studies Program coordinator or with the course instructor if you have any question about whether a particular course is foundational.
3. The courses offered in the China, India, and Japan programs count toward an Asian Studies minor and combined major.
