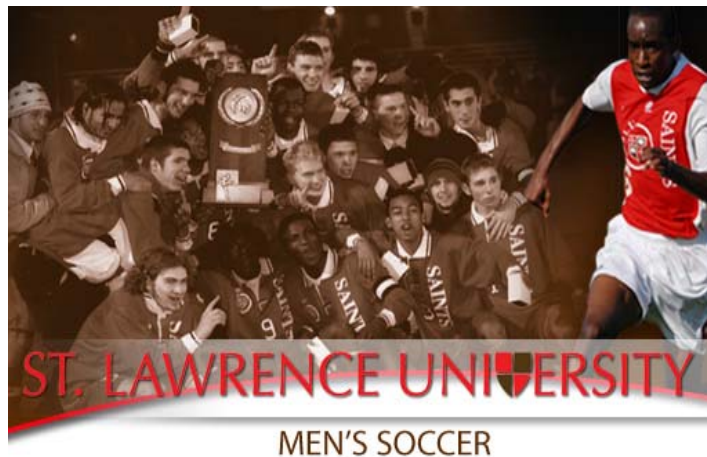

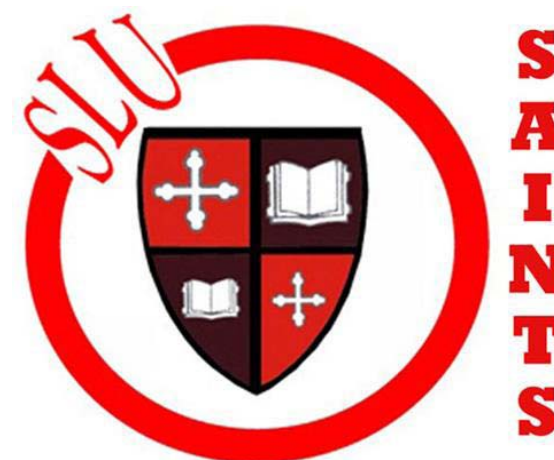

About the Coaches

Bob Durocher: Head Men's Coach



Just the third coach in St. Lawrence University history to earn national coach of the year honors, Saint soccer coach Bob Durocher has built one of the finest Division III soccer programs in the nation in a relatively

short time. His 1999 team became the first team in NCAA Division III history to go undefeated and untied en route to a national championship and Durocher was named NSCAA Division III Coach of the Year for his efforts. Since then, the Saints have compiled an impressive 153-44-20 overall record. He was Northeast Regional Coach of the Year in 1998, 1999, 2002 and 2010, while also being Coach of the Year several times in the UCAA before the conference became the Liberty League, where he earned the honor in both 2004, 2007, and 2010.

Ben Jordan: Men's Soccer Assistant Coach



Ben Jordan, a 2008 graduate of Division III power Messiah College, played on 3 national championship teams and compiled an 89-6-2 record in his collegiate career. Before St. Lawrence, he

was an assistant coach at Penn State University from 2009-2010. He currently holds his NSCAA Regional License.

Luke Seymour: Goalkeeping Coach



Luke Seymour, a 2011 graduate of Canisius College, played 4 years of goalkeeper. A Canton native who was All NY State in 2005 and a New England School Prep All Star

at Avon Old Farms in 2006. He holds his NSCAA Level 3 GK Certificate and has worked on the Lake Placid and Coastal Carolina soccer camp staffs.
