Sneak Peek:

The St. Lawrence University women's hockey team will look to pick up its first conference victories of the season when they welcome Yale and Brown to Appleton Arena. The Saints have never lost to Yale in 28 all-time meetings and have won the last 10 meetings with Brown.

Against the Top-10:

St. Lawrence finished last season with a 4-7-0 (.364) record against ranked foes. The wins came against Dartmouth (2), Harvard and Boston College.

The Saints came from behind last weeked against both nationally-ranked #9 BU and then-#3 UNH, but fell to #3 Clarkson 4-1 on Tuesday. The Saints enter the weekend with a 0-1-2 record against ranked foes this season. The remaining schedule includes several other top-10 teams including the Big Green and Crimson, Mercyhurst, and Clarkson.

Unranked = Unphased:

The Scarlet and Brown have found recent success against unranked teams. The Saints are 42-7-4 against unranked since 2007-08 for an .830 win percentage.

Neither Yale nor Brown enters this weekend's series ranked in the top-10 nationally.

Conference Choice:

The head coaches of ECAC Hockey voted St. Lawrence as the pre-season favorites to win the program's first ECAC Hockey championship.

St. Lawrence finished with 107 points behind three first place ballots, narrowly edging out Harvard for the distinction as pre-season No. 1. The Crimson followed with 103 points and three first place votes in second place while Dartmouth, the defending conference tournament champion, finished third with 93 points.

Princeton (89) and Clarkson (85) rounded out the top five teams in the pre-season poll. The final seven slots in the coaches' pre-season rankings 6-12 included Rensselaer (74), Cornell (68), Colgate (52), Quinnipiac (37), Yale (34), Brown (24) and Union (11).

Three = Victory:

The Saints' magic number over the last two seasons was undoubtedly 3; when the team scored 3 or more goals, they were an impressive 46-0-2.

St. Lawrence kept that unblemished record in tact last weekend, scoring three goals to tie UNH. The team extended that figure to 48-0-4 (.962) when scoring three times.

Wells's World:

After Paul Flanagan announced that he'd be heading to Syracuse University to help start its women's hockey program in the spring of 2008, the St. Lawrence athletic department announced the hiring of Chris Wells. A Canton, NY native and 1992 graduate of St. Lawrence, Wells took over after serving five years as the Associate Head Coach of the men's hockey program.

Under Coach Wells, St. Lawrence has worked to bring intensity to both ends of the ice, as he consistently preaches back-checking by his forwards and sound special teams play.

Coach Wells posted an impressive first season behind the bench, as his team has climbed as high as No. 3 in the polls and finished second in the regular season standings. The Saints also earned their sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid and finished 24-11-3 under Wells' guidance.

Injury Bug Bites:

It didn't take the injury bug long to bite the St. Lawrence women's hockey team in 2009-10.

Less than four minutes into the first period of the Scarlet and Brown's exhibition game against McGill, junior standout forward Karell Emard went to the ice in pain and had to be helped to the bench.

Emard's injury has been diagnosed as an ACL tear, though she is played for the first time this season against Clarkson on Tuesday. Her status remains questionable for the remainder of the season.

Meanwhile, juniors Kirsten Roach (leg) and Michelle Zimmerman (arm) are slated to miss several games due to injury.

"Chart"ing Success:

Much of the Saints' success last season can be traced to the fantastic play between the pipes by goaltender Brittany Chartier.

Chartier finished 13th in the nation in save percentage (.925) and 17th in goals against average (2.04). She was named the ECAC Hockey Goaltender of the Week three times and finished only one shutout away from tying the University's single-season record (5).

Chartier also proved her value in the postseason, as she was second in the NCAA Tournament with a .932 save percentage against national runner-up Mercyhurst.

Brittany was the starting goaltender for the University of Minnesota during their run to the NCAA Tournament Finals in 2006. She played nearly every minute in goal for St. Lawrence in 2008-09, and had a perfect 21-0-0 record when her team took a lead into the third period.

Rookie Rewards:

Three different members of the SLU Women's Hockey Class of 2013 have earned ECAC Hockey Rookie of the Week award in consecutive weeks.

Most recently, first-year Kayla Sullivan earned the honor after her performances against BU and UNH. The Caledonia, ON native scored the game-tying goal in the final minutes against the Wildcats while adding an assist on the game-tying goal against the Terriers.

Classmates Kelly Sabatine and Jamie Goldsmith earned the honor each of the previous two weeks.

Captain Ak-Attack:

St. Lawrence University senior captain Tara Akstull will look to lead the St. Lawrence offense in 2009-10. The Clifton Park, NY native is the Saints' top-returning scorer from last season. Akstull finished with 32 points on 13 goals and 19 assists.

Akstull, the team's lone "C", has picked up right where she left off last season. With three points in seven games, #7 is now within 9 points of the 100+ career point mark.

Joining Akstull as assistant captains for the 2009-10 season are seniors Britni Smith, Brittony Chartier and Courtney Sawchuk.

Saints Strike Gold:

First-year student Jamie Goldsmith is off to an impressive start with the Scarlet and Brown. The Media, PA native scored the first two goals of her collegiate career against Providence, helping her team secure a 3-3 tie.

For her efforts, Goldsmith was named the ECAC Hockey Rookie of the Week. She then went on to add a goal and an assist in the weekend sweep of Robert Morris.

Na, Na, Na, Na...Hey, Hey, Hey...:

After four outstanding seasons that included four NCAA Tournament Appearances and two Frozen Fours, the St. Lawrence women's hockey team was forced to say "goodbye" to the five members of the Class of 2009: Carson Duggan, Alison Domenico, Marianna Locke, Lisa Batchelor and Jordan Pyers.

The quintet accumulated 515 career points at St. Lawrence, with Duggan holding the all-time goals record (101). She, Domenico and Locke also became members of the "Century Club," earning 100 collegiate points.

One familiar face St. Lawrence will see in 2009-10 belongs to Locke, as she is working as an assistant coach at Union College.

Blue Line Brooke:

Jamie Goldsmith was not the only first-year student to get into the scoring during the opening weekend: rookie defenseman Brooke Fernandez also had a solid debut.

The Bloomfield, CT native picked up an assist against both Connecticut and Providence and was one of only two players to score a point in each game (Tara Akstull). She also added an assist in the Robert Morris series.

Bero-meter Reading:

St. Lawrence University sophomore forward Alley Bero will be one of the key weapons for the Saints in 2009-10. The Akwesasne, NY native led the Class of 2012 with 23 points (12 goals, 11 assists) in 34 games.

Bero was named the team's "Rookie of the Year" last spring, and will no doubt be looking to put plenty of pressure on opposing goaltenders this season. Bero is tied for third on the team with four points (2g,2a) thus far in 2009-10.

Taming the B's:

In recent years, St. Lawrence has found great success against both the Bulldogs of Yale and the Bears of Brown.

St. Lawrence enters Friday's game with an unblemished record of 27-0-1 in 28 meetings with Yale. The Saints have won 24 straight dating back to the 1999 season.

Despite losing the first six meetings against Brown, St. Lawrence has battled back to take the lead in the all-time series (15-14-2) thanks to 10 straight wins dating back to the spring of 2005.

The Saints have outscored Brown 48-15 during the 10-game winning streak, though the Bears have played SLU tough in each of the last three meetings, losing by the identical score of 3-2.

The Century Club:

The Saints welcomed one player into the "Century Club" last season, as forward Marianna Locke reached the 100+ point plateau. The Brasher Falls, NY native tallied a short-handed goal against Ohio State on Nov. 28 to reach the mark.

Three players earned spots in the 100+ point club in 2007-08, including Carson Duggan, Alison Domenico and Annie Guay. Duggan became the 12th player to join the exclusive "Century Club" after racking up four goals against Brown and Yale, including a hat trick against the Bears. Meanwhile, Guay was the first defenseman to earn a slot with 103 career points.

St. Lawrence may be welcoming the 16th member to its exclusive list this season, as senior Tara Akstull is only 9 points shy entering the Clarkson game. Junior Karell Emard is nearly halfway to 100 points after two years of collegiate hockey.
