Offered jointly by the departments of music, speech and theatre, and fine arts, “Collaboration Across the Arts” is a course that provides students from different backgrounds the opportunity to work together on creative projects of their own design. The direction of the course is determined to a great extent by the unique combination of students who participate. Class time was spent on a variety of activities: learning to use digital media technologies, viewing example works, discussing works-in-progress, and exploring various issues pertinent to technology-based art and collaborative processes through reading, writing, and discussion.

This semester’s students developed a diverse group of projects, using a variety of media (video, still images, audio, text) and a variety of techniques (digital editing, signal processing, MIDI sequencing, stop-motion animation). They have also chosen to address a variety of themes, one of which you will be challenged to figure out for yourself.
