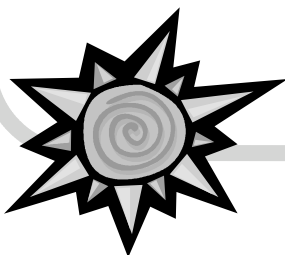

  - ✧ Career Search: This is another great way of looking for an internship. You will need to create a new account with the client referral number being stlawu04. It can be found on the Career Services webpage.
  - ✧ Vault Career: This is more of an industry exploration database, but still offers some very good internship information. It is also located on Career Services webpage and you will be required to use your ID number to get a password.
  - ✧ Others: Other search engines that you could use include Google, internships.com, Monster.com.
