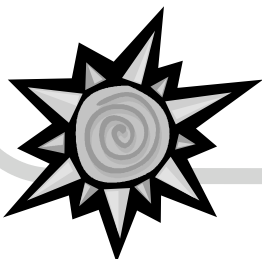

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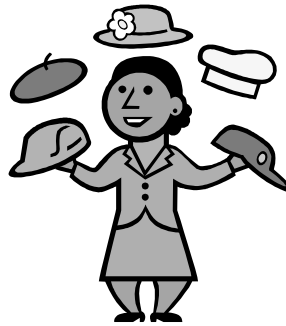

Manage Your Time

First Year :

- Know your interests, abilities, goals and values
- Visit the Career Services Office
- Be familiar with CareerSLUth, and complete your profile
- Consider participating in the Shadow-A-Saint program
- Be involved in your community



Second Year :

- Build your credentials
- Create your resume
- Learn about careers that interest you
- Attend workshops and events that you think will elaborate on your intended career
- Consider doing an internship
- Speak with your academic advisor about a possible major

Third Year :

- Gain practical experience in your field of choice
- Begin researching your post-graduate possibilities
- Develop basic job search skills
- Complete a professional resume
- Hold at least 4 professional information interviews: Connect and network with possible employers

Fourth Year :

- Develop a concrete job search plan
