



There's something different about our washers they open in the front, but that's not all...

Did you know that the new washers are rated CEE (consortium for energy efficiency)?

Compared to our old machines they save:

34% water
48% heating
51% electricity

Common Questions:

1. Why can I only use 2 tablespoons of soap?

-The machines use less water and if you add too much soap the machine will activate a safety feature, not enter high spin mode, leave your laundry soaking wet and put the machine out of service

2. Why do the new machines take longer?

-They don't, the old machines only showed the wash time, the new machines display the entire cycle length

3. Why are the new machines smaller?

-They aren't, they hold the same amount 22 pounds (about eight pairs of jeans)

4. What temperature is each setting?

-Bright colors, woolens and delicates are cold water; colors are warm water; whites are hot water

5. Why didn't we get new dryers?

-Dryers will be replaced over the next few years; the new washers spin more water out of the laundry so you will need less time to get things dry
