

Confidentiality at the Torrey Center

The Diana B. Torrey '82 Health and Counseling Center is legally and ethically obligated to protect every student's right to privacy. Health records are strictly confidential and maintained in compliance with federal and New York State laws, including the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and the Family Educational rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Center staff will not release information to anyone outside the Center including family, parent/legal guardians, SLU faculty/staff, or outside agencies, without the written authorization of the student, unless required by law. In the case of a minor, the authorization of a parent or legal guardian is required to release medical records. In a medical emergency, only relevant health information will be released to another healthcare provider.

If a student wishes to release his/her records to another provider, authorization forms are available at the center.
