During the 2009-2010 academic year, an area will be provided for students who prefer to live on a Quiet Study Floor. The Quiet Study Floor will be located in the 3400s of Sykes. This floor feature doubles, singles, and one triple room. Rooms will be assigned beginning with the lowest lottery numbered applicant.

GOAL: To create an environment for students who choose to place emphasis on quiet study. All residents must be committed to the following guidelines:

1. Residents of the Quiet Study Floor must
