During the 2009-2010 academic year, an area for students who wish to live in a substance-free living area will be offered through the Residence Life Office. Substance-Free Living location will be the 4th floor of Whitman which includes both single and double rooms. Rooms will be assigned beginning with the lowest lottery numbered applicant.

GOAL: To create an environment for students who choose to live in a substance-free environment.

As a member of the Substance-Free Living Community, I agree that:

1. I will maintain an alcohol and substance (tobacco products and illegal substances) free environment.
2. I will not bring alcohol or substances into the residence at any time, with or without the intent to consume. I understand that this also includes any of these products' empty containers.
3. As a member of the substance-free community, I also understand that my guests will not be permitted to bring substances or alcohol into the building, with or without the intent to consume.
4. As a member I agree that neither I, nor my guests, will return to the residence in an intoxicated and disruptive manner.
5. I recognize that if I fail to follow guidelines 1-4, I may be relocated to another living area.

I have read the Substance-Free Living guidelines and agree to abide by them in full should I be placed on the Substance-Free Floor.
