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Based a recent quarterly review and update of the ProAct formulary, a number of medications will change in their tier level within the formulary leading to a change in copay starting 4/1/09. While a greater number of medications will become cheaper on your plan, there are a number of people that may be adversely affected by this change leading to an increase in copay.

We at ProAct wanted to notify you of these potential changes prior to picking up your prescriptions. The following are some examples of medications that will move to a different tier April 1<sup>st</sup> 2009.

**New Generics Available:**

Divalproex ER (Depakote ER)

**Additions to Tier II:** *Preferred Brand*

Caduet, Crestor, Trilipix

**Additions to Tier III (removed from Tier II):** *Non-Preferred Brand*

Advicor, Simcor

We encourage you to contact your benefits department for the most up to date formulary for your plan. If you are currently taking any medication that has been moved to the Third Tier and are interested in an alternative medication on Tier I or Tier II, please bring a copy of your formulary to your pharmacist or physician to discuss your treatment options, or contact the ProAct Pharmacy Services Clinical Department at 315-287-3652 x624.
