A student may <u>withdraw</u> from a course until **November 6, 2025**, by filing a properly executed course withdrawal form in the Registrar's Office; notation of withdrawal appears on the transcript. Three and one-half units are required to maintain full time status. Students may exercise the option to <u>withdraw</u> from a course only twice before graduation. Students with an exceptional case may petition the Academic Petitions Committee.
