 - (f) North America
 - (g) Transnational
- At least one of the ten courses must be a 299 pro-seminar
- At least one course at the 300 level is required.
- At least one of the ten courses must be a Senior Year Experience (SYE) that may be fulfilled by a 400-level research seminar involving a substantial research project, by the two-semester Honors Project, or by a 400-level independent study
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA in the major
