Historical Note

The AAUW was founded by a group of 17 college women in Boston, Massachusetts, in 1881. During that period of time women were hindered by many barriers that prevented them from pursuing both higher education and obtaining work in specialized fields. The primary objective of AAUW was the betterment of women's lives and their personal growth and that a greater number of college-educated women would be of benefit to society in general.

On May 4, 1927, the St. Lawrence County Branch of AAUW was formed in Canton, New York at the home of Mrs. Harold Bergman. The 1927-1928-charter membership for AAUW included...(?) The charter members adopted a constitution, Article II reads; "The purpose of the branch shall be to unite college women of the vicinity for work on the educational, Civic and social problems of the community, and cooperate with the American Association of University Women in its general work."

Scope and Content

Included in the collection are minutes of meetings, financial records, constitution and by-laws, correspondence, newsletters, photographs and original documents found in scrapbooks, newspaper clippings and fourteen cassette tapes from national conferences pertaining to the St. Lawrence County Branch of AAUW.
